Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 18 November 2020.

You asked the Money and Pensions Service the following in respect of the Single Financial Guidance Body:

“Could you please provide up to date Names, Job Titles, telephone numbers and email addresses for the following; Chief Executive, Deputy Chief Executive, Ministers and Ministerial team (if applicable), Chair, Chief Information Officer, Chief Digital Officer, Senior Information Risk Owner, Director of IT / ICT / IM&T / Digital / Information / Technology, Director / Head of Finance, Chief / Deputy Chief Operating Officer, Head of Cyber Security, Head / Director of People, Heads of change / Transformation / Improvement, Department Directors / Heads Board members (if applicable) Or the equivalent job titles in your organisation.

In addition, if you have an up-to-date 2020 senior staff organisation or structure chart could you please forward a copy to me in either Excel or pdf format.”

Money and Pensions Service Response:

On 1 January 2019, Pension Wise, The Pensions and Advisory Service and the Money Advice Service merged to form the Single Financial Guidance Body, an arms-length body of the Department for Work and Pensions. These businesses became known as the Money and Pensions Service (MaPS) on the 1 April 2019. MaPS aims to deliver advice relating to pensions, money guidance, debt advice, and consumer protection.

I can confirm MaPS holds information relevant to your request but some of the information is exempt. Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act states I am unable to disclose staff members details which are not available in the public domain. To do so would contravene the data protection principles. For this reason, I can only disclose information about a member of staff that is already available in the public domain.
